






LIFE- Clean Energy Transition (CET)

- √ 7 years budget of almost €1 bn

LIFE Clean Energy Transition (CET) - Call 2021

- First Call open with 18 topics
- EUR 95 million available
- Deadline 12 January 2022
- > 170 proposals received
- Next LIFE Calls for proposals publication date: expected 17th of May 2022





Addressing energy poverty

Policy relevance

- Support the implementation of provisions related to energy poverty (Clean Energy for All Europeans package, EED, EPBD, Renovation Wave)
- Address acute housing affordability challenge in Europe
- Knowledge sharing and local level support via the Energy Poverty Advisory Hub

Priorities

- Facilitate energy efficient behaviour change and investments for energy poor households
- Transform inefficient housing stock in vulnerable districts
- Foster collaboration between key actors (public authorities, social actors, NGOs, utilities)
- Develop and identify best practices and policy recommendations

Approaches under IEE & H2020

- Supporting energy poor consumers in the adoption of more energy efficient behaviours through energy advice and low-cost measures (e.g. SAVES2, STEP-IN, ASSIST, SMART-UP, EmpowerMed, STEP)
- Facilitating EE and RES collective and cooperative action for the benefit of energy poor households (e.g. POWERPOOR, POWER UP!)
- Setting up alternative financing models geared towards supporting energy poor household investments (e.g. SCORE)
- Supporting energy efficiency measures at the building level (e.g. ComAct)
- Setting up and supporting innovative schemes by obligated parties under Art 7 EED (e.g. SocialWatt, ENPOR)

Facilitate uptake of renovation approaches for large-scale rollout of building-related interventions

Roll out holistic, industrialised deep renovation solutions

Develop and implement roadmaps of EE measures




